How to enter

- Select the turnover category that your company sits in, and click Register.

- You will be redirected to the CCNZ Member Dashboard >> Award Applications.
- Select the category you have just entered and enter in your company details and the contact person's details if they differ to yours, click the save button.
- Submit a marketing statement and photos, these will be used in the Awards Book.
- Scroll to the top of the screen and click the blue Submit Application button - and you are entered!
