Introduction

We have an exciting opportunity to be part of a new industry group supporting the goal of reducing deaths and serious injuries on temporary traffic work sites in New Zealand.

The strength of this new temporary traffic management (TTM) Steering Group will be in the diversity of membership and there are positions for 12 members representing different parts of the industry.

Steering Group Members will be expected to commit on average 4hrs per week to support the operation and function of the Steering Group and at this stage is intended to operate for a 12 month period with potential for further extensions. The Steering Group will report directly to the Road Worker Safety Governance Group (RWSGG)

Responsibilities & Duties

- Represent your industry in the TTM Steering Group by capturing the views and feedback from industry body members and/or directly for representatives from your respective industry practitioners
- Support the identification of key risks and their priority in relation to the successful transition to the NZGTTM
- Support the development of a strategy and plan that defines and maps out scopes for transition workstreams
- Establish and hold accountable 'sub-committees' who will develop and implement key action plans
- Identify and support the required communications through your respective industry channels
- Serve as a champion for the dissemination of information to the groups that you represent
- Report back and work with the RWSGG to agree key focuses on the most important needs for the industry transitioning to the NZGTTM

We're looking for members who are well connected across respective industry bodies in the area of Temporary Traffic Management. You will ideally have had practical experience in TTM and have been following the developments of the new NZGTTM. Being passionate about a successful transition for the industry will be important and helpful in this role as change agents for the NZGTTM.
