### Experience Descriptors

- **Governance** – an understanding of governance principles, practices and processes that determine how industry assembled groups collaborate to achieve pan industry outcomes.
- **Technical** – extensive knowledge of all technical aspects relevant for TTM, including on-site experience,
- **Regulatory/Legal** – extensive knowledge of the legislation and regulations that are impacting TTM. Preferably strong network in the respective legislative environment.

- **Operational/Delivery** – solid experience with applying relevant TTM practices and guidelines on a wide range of traffic situations in different contexts (local roads, state highways, event management)
- **Procurement** – strong experience in procurement by having been in a lead role for various procurement processes
- **Health, Safety & Wellbeing** – recognized as a champion in Health, Safety & Wellbeing by their peers
- **Training & Competency** – Understanding of the TTM practice area, the NZGTTM and the associated needs for worker training and competency to enable safe practices
- **Risk Management** – strong knowledge and experience of existing risk management processes and practices preferably where relevant to TTM
- **Project Management** – solid experience on wide range of projects (size, scope, budget, duration, etc)
