



# **Background**

Since 1995, Kiwi excavator operators have been competing in the annual Civil Contractors New Zealand National Excavator Operator Competition, an event still going strong. In the national event, the champions of CCNZ's Regional Excavator Operator Competitions (REOCs) compete in March each year at the Central District Field Days in Feilding.

Operators are put through a variety of challenges. Some tasks are designed to promote safe work practices and demonstrate the 'real-world' skills of excavator operators, such as traversing a trench, lifting and relocation of a manhole cover, whilst others are oriented towards being fun and unusual to test control skills and engage spectators: pouring a cup of tea, 'slam dunking' a basketball, painting a sign or opening a beer bottle!

Operators are required to demonstrate their knowledge of regulations related to health and safety, first aid, Land Transport Regulations and industry hazards. Having completed the safety and regulation part of the contest, operators are required to manoeuvre a 12 tonne excavator through the course, staying clear of known hazards while completing tasks that demonstrate skills required of an excavator operator by the industry.


- Test the operators' ability and show the innovation of plant and equipment
